Mon 10th	Reflect on the faithfulness and the word of God as we are humbled and tested in different ways.
Tues 11th	"When the poor one called out, the Lord heard." Lord, we pour out our hearts to you today. Thank You for hearing us.
Wed 12th	"The Lord is King, in splendour robed." Lord, we thank You that You are King of Kings, Majesty.
Thurs 13th	ASCENSION Lord, be with those who are preparing to serve in the sacred ministry. We remember your Apostles as they waited after the Ascension for the gift of the Holy Spirit. They met together for prayer and fellowship in preparation for the coming change to their lives. Encourage those in training today and those who support them.
Fri 14th	We commit to praying for friends and family, in the days between Ascension and Pentecost, to come to know the love, hope and peace found in Christ.

THANKS	Sat 15th	Come, Holy Spirit, and fill our hearts with deep thankfulness. Show my friends and family how much God is doing for them.
SORRY	Sun 16th	Lord Jesus Christ, have mercy on me a sinner; Lord Jesus Christ have mercy on my friends and family, sinners like me.
OFFER	Mon 17th	Come, Holy Spirit, and give me the rest I long for; fill my friends and family with a yearning for you.
PRAY	Tues 18th	Come, Holy Spirit, and complete your work of grace in me; enable my friends and family to recognise that you are working in them already.
HELP	Wed 19th	Come, Holy Spirit, and give me the gift of rock-solid faith; may my friends and family see my faith in you and be inspired to search for you and find faith in you.
ADORE	Thur 20th	Come, Holy Spirit, and show me the way to come home; show my friends and family that you are waiting for them with outstretched arms.
CELEBRATE	Fri 21st	Come, Holy Spirit, and give me the strength to hold my friends and family up to you, and prod them to discover your delight in them.
SILENCE	Sat 22nd	Lord, God, as I rest in your presence help me to hold my friends and family there; help them to experience your presence today.
Sun 23rd		PENTECOST As we celebrate your outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the church, we also recall your Holy Spirit 'hovering over the waters' since before the beginning of time. Help us to remember your power, creativity and love, and to trust you in all things.
Mon 24th		Luke 6:36 " You must be compassionate, just as your Father is compassionate ". Pray for a heart of compassion as we hear or read the news.
Tues 25th		Pray for our government - for wisdom, integrity and humility.

Wed 26th	We pray for the hospitals in this area, especially at this time of Covid, for the Specialists and Doctors, for the nurses, especially those working in intensive care. We remember, as we hold them in our prayers, the physical and emotional demands this makes upon them.
Thurs 27th	We pray for the local care homes, for the managers and the care staff and the residents in their care. The challenges of keeping them in contact with friends and relatives, maintaining a routine of social life and support, and outside contacts and visits, while still protecting the health of other residents and staff.
Fri 28th	We pray for those who work on medical research and development as doctors learn to cope with new strains of the Covid virus and the dangers these present to our welfare.
Sat 29th	We pray for those working in international charities to bring vaccines to states lacking resources to develop or produce these themselves, and for greater foresight and generosity in this area. We pray for the United Nations and its agencies, for the World Health Organization, and in particular the COVAX and VaccinAid schemes.
Sun 30th	<p>TRINITY SUNDAY</p> <p>Father, thank you for your love: draw my family and friends into that love.</p> <p>Jesus, thank you for your gift of yourself: help them to accept and appreciate that gift.</p> <p>Holy Spirit, give them life and bring them home.</p>
