Tues 7th	<p>○ Lord, our provider we thank you for all your gifts that you richly supply us with. Make us willing to share these gifts with those in physical and spiritual need.</p>

Wed 8th	Do not neglect the gift that is in you. 1 Timothy 4:14. Give thanks for the variety of talents and skills at KPC - your own in particular. How could they be further developed?
Thurs 9th	Always give thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Ephesians 5:20. Take time for a praise pause! Count your blessings not your burdens.
Fri 10th	Feed the hungry and help those in trouble. Then your light will shine out from the darkness, and the darkness around you will be as bright as noon. Isaiah 58:10. Pray for the resourcing of the King's Foodbank, and for all those who need to use it.
Sat 11th	O Lord, our Healer, look down on us in our infirmities and help us to bear them patiently. We pray that we may bring comfort to all those who are suffering in any way, especially those affected by any of the different aspects of the pandemic.
Sun 12th	Breathe on me, breath of God, fill me with life anew.
